DESCRIPTION

The laminator works with a crew of other laminators to build fiberglass parts of the boat that may include the deck, hull or small parts using a hand lay-up process to apply the skincoat and bulkcoat laminate, core materials and final layer of laminate.

DUTIES (Include but not limited to)

Measure and cut various fiberglass materials.
Use various hand tools to apply and roll out wet fiberglass materials properly without air voids.
Properly use mill gauges while laminating.
Apply materials by hand
Keep work area clean and orderly
Follow all application guidelines and instructions for quality control

SKILLS

Use basic tools applicable to the job
Work with people as a team to accomplish department goals
Roll out fiberglass without laminate defects such as air bubbles, etc.
Inspect parts for gelcoat and laminate defects throughout the process to ensure high quality standards
Understand laminate related materials, methods and practices used in the department
Has knowledge in proper handling and mixing gelcoats, resins, and catalysts
Understand safe handling and disposal of hazardous chemicals and emergency procedures
Adapt to changes in production operations
